The Truro Agricultural Fair celebrates Barnstable County's agriculture and educates about the health of our bodies, community and environment. TIME: Set Up: 7am – 8:30 (Cars must be off field by 8:30) Fair: 10am - 3pm Clean up: 3pm – 4pm

YOU PROVIDE: table, seating and shade if desired (umbrella or tent), display, educational materials, interactive activities/games, sunscreen. Note: Tents must be secured – bear in mind most spaces are on the road, so stakes won't work. Please bring weights for stabilization. Multiple gallon water jugs bungied to each corner of tents work if you don't have weights.

WE PROVIDE: A 10' x 10' space and a fun day! (More space may be available upon request.)

BOOTHS MUST INCLUDE 3 COMPONENTS:

- **Be Educational** – Informational booths will explain some aspect of your organization's work and how it relates to the sustainability of our environment or food system.
- **Be Interactive** - Each booth must engage the public with an interactive display. (For instance, the beekeepers have a demo beehive in glass where children & adults play "Find the Queen", the composting table runs demos at specific times, etc.)
- **Clearly Suggest a Call to Action** - Each booth must suggest an action a person could take to ensure the future health of Cape Cod – "What You Can Do": (for instance don't use pesticides on flowers to ensure the bees' health, compost your table scraps to reduce waste, etc.)

ACCEPTANCE: Educators will be accepted on a space-available basis. Prior collaborators who have clearly fulfilled our educational mission have preference. If accepted, you will be notified in early August.

- In the spirit of our mission, only local food items may be sold at the fair by local food harvesters and/or local restaurants with prior permission of *both* Sustainable CAPE and the Truro Board of Health. **No other items may be sold by participants.** This stipulation ensures that all money that changes hands DIRECTLY supports the local food vendors we work with and for whom this celebration exists. No money can be exchanged at educational booths nor any items sold, but educators may offer membership information, have sign-ups for mailing lists, and give away promotional and education items.
- Applicants assume all responsibility of risk for any loss connected to the reservation and/or use of space at the Truro Agricultural Fair. Organizers of the Truro Agricultural Fair and any related organizations shall in no way be liable to the applicant (or other persons the applicant may employ) for damage to property or any other injury.
- The organizers of the Truro Agricultural Fair have the right to cancel the event due to unforeseen and unavoidable circumstances. The right to cancel shall continue during the course of the Fair.
- Applicants agree to indemnify and hold the Sustainable CAPE, and their agents, employees, officers, and members of board of directors harmless for any injury to person or property, including loss of life associated with or arising from the applicant’s participation in the Fair and all associated activities. Applicant shall indemnify and hold the Sustainable CAPE and all those associates listed above harmless and shall pay damages, costs and expenses and reasonable attorney’s fees that may be incurred or paid by Sustainable CAPE in connection with any litigation arising from this applicant’s participation in the Truro Agricultural Fair and associated activities.
- Cancellations MUST be made in writing one week prior to the Fair date.
